FAQ's

What time is check-in on the first day?

Check-in starts at 8:30am on the first day of camp.

What is the earliest I can bring my child to camp?

If you have purchased the early drop off you can bring campers starting at 8:00am. All other campers can drop off starting at 8:30am. Please note if you drop off before 8am you will be charged for early drop-off. Camp activity starts every morning at 9:00am.

Are there any scholarship opportunities for my child to attend summer camp?

We do not provide scholarship opportunities for our summer camp program at this time.

Are there any sibling discounts for camp?

For parents/guardians with more than one camper sibling discounts may be provided. To determine eligibility for sibling discounts please contact youthprograms@dolphins.com.

I cannot pick up at 4:00pm, do you offer after care?

YES! After care is available until 5pm each day. The cost for after care is \$100 for the week.

I don't need both after care and before care can I just pay for one?

The cost of before care and after care is a flat fee of \$100 for the entire week. There are no options to choose your days or times a la carte.

My child can no longer attend camp, can I get a refund?

Yes, you are able to receive a full refund up until the first day of camp by email request. Please email us at youthprograms@dolphins.com to submit your refund request.

My camper wants to be on the same team as another camper this week, is that possible?

Yes, you can fill out their names during registration or email us at youthprograms@dolphins.com with the names of both campers and which week they are attending.

Are there athletic trainers at camp?

Yes, all Junior Dolphins camps have Certified Athletic Trainers on-site to deal with any illness or injury.

My child has an epi-pen, inhaler, or other medical concern, who can I talk to?

Please see our athletic trainer on the first day of camp to share any medical concerns.

Will there be Dolphins players at camp?

Due to scheduling demands we do not announce ahead of time which and if Dolphins players will attend camp. Most camps will have a Dolphin player, alumni, or coach to appear at camp.



Someone other than myself will be picking my child up from camp?

On the first day of camp, you will be providing a four digit number for your camper. Share that number with any adult authorized to pick up your camper. They will provide the number at check out and be allowed to take the camper.
